Proposed Cultural Visit to Wrexham in North Wales. June/July 2009

The **INVITATION** is for two young people to be guests of the Rotary Club of Wrexham Erddig for a period of three weeks during the summer of 2009.

Age: Must be at least 18 years old on arrival in U.K. and ideally, no more than 21.

Cost: They will be required to pay their own Flight and Insurance costs. They will also need to pay for their own out of pocket personal expenses, some meals and the cost of telephone calls home.

Expenses: Our Rotary Club will meet all of the accommodation and travel costs within the Rotary district, entrance fees to places of interest and most meals.

Accommodation: Initially with a host family for a few days, then at student accommodation at *Glyndwr University* (formally the *North East Wales Institute*). The University has many students from Continental Europe visiting during the summer months, which opens up a variety of social opportunities. The final few days will be spent with their host family before returning home.

Restriction: Due to the nature and limited availability of the Student Accommodation, our visitors should be of the same sex.

Itinerary: A detailed itinerary will be produced for the visit. We will introduce our guests to the wide and varied culture and geography of North Wales and North West England. One of the highlights will be a visit to the famous Llangollen International Eisteddfod. For most of the time, they will be either accompanied or supervised. However, we recognize that some free time is essential, and we are able to call upon former GRSP students and their families to assist in this respect.

Vocational: Where possible, we will also arrange a number of career-related visits.

Dates: Ideally arrive mid-week to take advantage of cheaper flight costs, arriving Wednesday June 24 or July 01, returning approx. 3 weeks later. Student accommodation will be for the two weeks from Sunday June 28 or July 05.

Travel: Flights should be booked to **MANCHESTER** England, where our guests would be met for the 45 minute journey to Wrexham.
