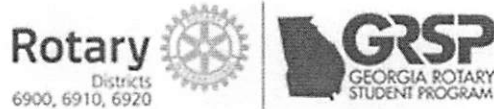


**GEORGIA ROTARY STUDENT PROGRAM**

**Directions:**

Continue straight on Montgomery Street past the Savannah Civic Center across Oglethorpe Avenue then across Broughton Street, around Franklin Square to Bay Street. Turn right on Bay and go approximately 0.8 miles. The Marriott will be on your left at the “bottom of the hill.” Pull into the parking lot and come inside to the lobby. We’ll be waiting for you!

**Friday- October 11th**

- 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM Students arrive at the Savannah Marriott Riverfront Hotel, 100 General McIntosh Blvd., Savannah, GA 31401, (912) 233-7722. Registration and receipt of Savannah host family assignments. (A light snack will be provided). Free time to explore River Street.
- 7:00 PM to 8:30PM Dinner at the "Marriott" Hotel. Anyone with special dietary requirements is asked to notify Jim Drake ([jdrake@drakefirmpc.com](mailto:jdrake@drakefirmpc.com)), no later than Monday, October 7th.
- 8:40 PM to 10:00 PM Ghost Tour! Savannah is said to be one of the most haunted cities in the United States. Decide for yourself as you're taken through the shadowy streets of Savannah while hearing eerie tales of many of its historic homes!
- 10:00 PM to 11:00PM Return to Marriott for a bit of "calming down," before departing for weekend host family homes.
- 11:00 PM Students are picked up (at the Marriott Hotel) by their Savannah host families.

**Saturday- October 12th**

- 9:00 AM Students arrive (via host families) at The Mighty Eighth Air Force Museum (Pooler), to interactively experience World War II from both the European and American perspectives. Lunch will be provided. (Breakfast should be provided to students prior to transporting them to the museum).
- 12:00 PM Students depart museum via tour bus to Tybee Island.
- 1:00 PM Students arrive at historic Tybee Island Lighthouse. Considered one of the finest Lighthouses on the East Coast, it offers a, "You must see it to believe it", view of Tybee Island and the Atlantic Ocean. Did we say "climb?" Yes, you'll climb it all the way to the top!
- 2:30 PM to 6:00 PM Students enjoy an afternoon at the beach. Swimsuits and towels are suggested.
- 6:30 PM to 10:00 PM Dinner and fun at the beach. (Low Country Boil) Rotarians are invited to attend. (Rotarians and other guests will be charged the cost of their meal). Rotarians please RSVP to Jim Drake no later than, Monday, October 7th, to attend the low country dinner.
- 10:00PM Students leave Tybee Island and return to the Marriott Hotel via tour bus.
